



# INTERVIEW WITH TYANNE KELLY

Recipient of Service:
Stage 4 Breast Cancer
Survivor, finds hope at the
new Breast Cancer Support
Program by JFSA.

Tyanne Kelly was diagnosed with stage 2 breast cancer in 2009. She moved to Las Vegas in 2013 and was working as an insurance agent when she received her diagnosis. She was able to get through her first bout of cancer, but in 2022, her cancer returned, this time as stage 4.

Kelly was devastated, but she was determined to fight. She continued to work, but her cancer made it difficult. She was also struggling financially, as her medical bills were piling up.

One day, Kelly was referred to JFSA and met with Jill, a JFSA caseworker, to discuss her situation.

Jill was able to provide Kelly with a number of resources, including food delivery, gas cards, and therapy. She also helped Kelly to apply for financial assistance programs.

"JFSA has made my life so much easier," Kelly said. "Even the little things like getting gas cards for going to my treatments or going and picking up my medication have been a huge help."

Kelly is also grateful for the support group that JFSA offers. "It's been so helpful to meet other women who are going through the same thing," she said. "We can share our experiences and support each other."

Kelly is now living with cancer, not dying from it. She is determined to continue living her life to the fullest. She is also grateful for the support of JFSA and the other women in her support group.

"I want people to know that there is JFSA out there that can help," Kelly said. "Support groups are a game changer. No one understands what you're going through by yourself, but to have another person know exactly what you are going through is definitely amazing and important. Thank you JFSA for everything."

## JFSA LAUNCHES NEW BREAST CANCER SUPPORT PROGRAM

JFSA has launched a new program to support people with breast cancer. The Breast Cancer Support Program is a case management service that provides social and emotional support, resource management, and financial support to individuals and their families during this crucial time in their lives.

The program's social and emotional support component includes support groups, where people with breast cancer can connect with others who are going through the same experience. The Breast Cancer Support Program's resource management component provides clients with access to counseling, food, housing, and other resources. The program's financial support component helps clients with rent, food, and other expenses while they are undergoing treatment.

JFSA is the only organization in Las Vegas that offers all three of these components of support to people with breast cancer.

"We want everyone to know that we are here to help," said Jill Lund, the program manager. "Clients have said they wish this program existed way before, and we are grateful that we are able to offer it now."

"We want to show the community the impact that this program is having," said Dr. Sylvia Chang, Program Director. "No other organization in Las Vegas is prepared and set up the way we are currently. We offer social support, resource management, and financial support and customize each program to our clients' needs. We offer them help, hope, and support in the best way possible."
